# Legislative Updates: ACT Trends & National Influence

While the ACT has not yet adopted the full suite of NSW strata reforms, many of the changes are expected to influence future legislation locally. The ACT Legislative Assembly is currently reviewing unit title management, and the Strata Community Association (SCA) has called for modern, sustainable reforms.

#### Key areas include:

- Sustainability infrastructure: Encouraging solar panels and EV chargers.
- Accessibility upgrades: Lower voting thresholds for inclusive features.
- Committee governance: Clearer duties for fairness and transparency.
- Insurance transparency: Disclosure of premiums, commissions, and coverage.

These reforms aim to create more inclusive, sustainable, and well-governed strata communities. We recommend ACT owners corporations begin reviewing their by-laws and governance practices in anticipation of these changes.

## **Spring Maintenance Checklist**

Spring is the ideal time to inspect and refresh your property. A proactive approach now can prevent costly issues later. We recommend:

- Cleaning gutters and downpipes to prevent blockages from spring rains.
- Inspecting and testing irrigation systems for efficient water use.
- Pressure washing driveways, walkways, and building exteriors.
- Servicing air conditioning units before summer demand.
- Reviewing pest control measures for ants and termites.
- Checking fences, gates, and outdoor furniture for wear and tear.

### **Spring Gardening in Strata**

Celebrate the season with vibrant green spaces that enhance wellbeing and community pride. Shared gardens can become gathering points for residents, encouraging interaction and a sense of ownership. Consider:

- Planting colourful annuals and perennials.
- Refreshing mulch to conserve moisture and suppress weeds.
- Pruning shrubs and trees for healthy growth.
- Organising a community gardening day.
- Installing compost bins or worm farms to support sustainability.

Gardening also contributes to biodiversity and can reduce heat in urban environments.
